### Footnotes

I WANT TO DUST HER away well and tracked the dueling leaders while racing one from the rail into the first turn, stalked the pacesetters into the final turn, rallied two wide through the turn, tipped four wide into the stretch and took command in deep stretch and inched clear late. LORD HARLOW broke sharply and vied for the lead from the onset while racing along the rail, battled down the backside from the inside of PAYTON'S BEST, repelled a challenge by CALM THE STORM entering the stretch but was unable to hold off I WANT TO DUST HER in deep stretch. PAYTON'S BEST dueled for the lead one from the rail into the first turn, battled through the final turn from between rivals, only to fade slightly in deep stretch in a solid effort. CALM THE STORM was off a step slow, chased the dueling leaders three wide into the first turn, pressed the pace three wide approaching the final turn, battled three wide through the turn and into the stretch but hung in the late going. BAMBOO DREAM stumbled soon after the start to get away slowly, raced four wide into the first turn while trailing the field, rallied three from the rail on the final turn and was gaining through the stretch from the outside. BLUEGRASS MAN away alertly and tracked the leaders into the first turn while saving ground at the rail, continued to track down the backside but weakened over the final furlong. HONEY SKILA raced one from the rail into the first turn while being allowed to settle, but showed little.
