Footnotes

DYNA STROLL away alertly and rushed to the lead approaching the first turn racing one from the rail, vied for the lead down the backside and through the final turn from along the inside of SLICKSTER, took command entering the stretch and drew clear. EVALUATE (IRE) allowed to settle through the early stages while saving ground along the rail, commenced a rallied along the inside on the final turn and closed well through the stretch to get up for the place. SLICKSTER away well and chased the early pacesetter into the first turn racing three wide, dueled for the lead down the backside and through the final turn from the outside of DYNA STROLL, was unable to match strides with that rival through the stretch but battled well to hold on for a share. MUCHO VERDE broke sharply and tracked the leaders from just off the rail into the first turn, continued to track the dueling leaders through the final turn while racing one

from the rail, and finished evenly. AMBEKAY unhurried early while dropping back to trail, rallied along the inside on the final turn and improved his position through the final furlong. DE CAR GUY tracked the leaders into the backstretch while racing four wide, advanced four wide nearing the final turn to loom a danger, but hung through the final furlong. LATE NITE LARRY stalked the early leaders into the first turn racing four wide, rallied four wide on the final turn, but needed more of a closing response in the late stages. MOBIL SUPREME stalked the pace into the first turn racing three wide from between rivals, but lacked the needed closing response. GUNS N GOLD showed no early speed while lagging well back, raced just out from the rail, but failed to menace. DISTORTED GLAMOUR hopped at the start to get away slowly, raced wide throughout, and weakened over the final furlong.
