TAYLOR SAID broke sharply and raced to the lead through the first turn racing one from the rail, dueled from between rivals down the backside, battled through the final turn from along inside of ST LIAMS HALO, before drawing clear entering the stretch. THREE WOOD unhurried early while dropping back to trail, commenced a three wide rally entering the final turn and closed willingly through the stretch to get up for the place. SENOR ROJO away well, but allowed to settle off the early pace racing along the inside, advanced one from the rail mid way down the backside, rallied two wide through the final turn, and finished well in a solid effort. ST LIAMS HALO away alertly and tracked the early leader three wide into the stretch the first time, pressed the pace three wide down the backside, battled through the final turn from the outside of TAYLOR SAID, but faded in the stretch drive. NORTHERN CAUSEWAY steadied briefly off heels entering the first turn, tracked the leaders into the second turn from just off the rail, vied for the lead from along the inside in the run down the backside, but weakened over the final furlong. ISCAR was off a step slow, settled towards the rear while racing one from the rail, but failed to menace. SPAGHETTI MOUSE stalked the pace into the second turn racing two from the rail, but was through before reaching the final turn.
