Footnotes

YANG broke sharply and tracked the early pacesetter three wide through the stretch the first time, rolled up to pressed the pace three wide entering the backside, battled through the final furlong from the outside of TALUS RIDGE and prevailed in the closing strides. TALUS RIDGE away well and rushed to the lead one from the rail entering the first turn, held the lead into the second turn racing just out from the rail, vied from along the inside of YANG in the run down the backside, battled with that rival through the final furlong only to be passed in the final strides. COMMANDRESS stalked the pace four wide through the stretch the first time, continued one from the four path as they entered the backside, advanced from the outside mid way down the backstretch, but needed more over the final furlong. HILLINGDON unhurried early while dropping back to trail, raced three wide into the final turn, rallied four wide on the turn and improved her position without ever threatening. MARCADO away alertly and tracked the leader from along the rail into the first turn, dropped back to trail in the run down the backside, rallied one from the rail on the final turn, and closed with some late interest. DORREEN'S DELIGHT stalked the early pace racing one from the rail through the stretch the first time, held a striking position into the backside, but weakened over the final furlong.
