Footnotes

RIBOLETTO broke sharply and chased the early pacesetter through the first turn, was taken back and allowed to settle down the lane the first time around, advanced from along the rail mid way down the backstretch and was up in the final strides while closing at the rail. MAJESTICALITY away well and vied for the lead from the onset from along the inside, held a narrow advantage into the stretch but was unable to hold off a late charge by RIBOLETTO. BEARROCK N ROLL away alertly and chased the early pacesetters three wide on the first turn, pressed the pace one from the rail into the second turn and three wide on the backstretch, and battled gamely to the finish. KANONKULE unhurried early while saving ground along the inside, tipped three wide into the stretch the first time, and was gaining in the stretch, but unable to threaten. TRICK OF THE NORTH raced wide throughout, but showed some late interest. VICTOR'S MAGIC stalked the early pace from along the rail, tipped out to chase three wide down the backstretch, and weakened in the late stages.
