Footnotes

RANDOM HIGHS away alertly but was quickly taken in hand and dropped back to trail into the first turn, bided her time while awaiting room entering the final turn, rallied one from the rail on the turn, tipped three wide entering the stretch and quickly took command and inched clear. DELTA BOUQUET away well and dueled for the lead one from the rail, took a narrow advantage into the final turn, was collared by RANDOM HIGHS leaving the turn and was no match for that rival in the stretch drive, but battled gamely to hold the place. LADY SASHA tracked the leaders four wide into the first turn, continued to track one from the rail into the second turn, advanced three wide nearing the final turn, and closed willingly through the stretch to just miss the place. CAMINO broke sharply and vied for the lead into the second turn from the inside of DELTA BOUQUET, was unable to stay with that rival through the final turn and weakened in the stretch. SKOPA chased the pace three wide through the first turn, tracked two from the rail into the second turn, but was through mid way down the backstretch.
