**Footnotes**

THREE POINT PLAY unhurried early while dropping back to trail racing three wide into the first turn, advanced five wide soon after entering the backstretch, rallied five wide through the final turn and was up in the closing strides. SIR HAYDEN away alertly and chased the early leader into the first turn while racing three wide, pressed the pace from the outside of CANUCKS ROAR down the backside and through the final turn, took command entering the stretch but was unable to hold off THREE POINT PLAY in the final strides. MAN OVERBOARD showed no early speed while lagging towards the rear of the field, advanced three wide down the backside, rallied four wide through the final turn and improved his position while closing five wide in the stretch drive. GIMME DATT chased the early leaders into the first turn while racing one from the rail, tracked the dueling pacesetters down the backside from along the inside, held a striking position through the final turn, and closed willingly one from the rail through the stretch. LORD HENRY away well and stalked the early pace into the first turn from just off the rail, dropped back a bit in the run down the backside, rallied one from the rail on the final turn and closed four wide through the stretch. CANUCKS ROAR broke sharply and raced to the lead one from the rail into the first turn, vied for the lead from the inside of SIR HAYDEN down the backstretch and through the final turn, but faded in the stretch drive. NOTIS SAL chased five wide into the first turn, assumed a stalking position upon entering the backstretch while racing two from the rail, but weakened over the final furlong. EL NACHO stalked the early pace three wide into the first turn, but began to fade approaching the final turn. MR JIGSAW chased four wide into the first turn, but was through soon after entering the backside.
