MATCHABULL ducked out at the start, saved ground into the first turn while chasing the early pace, was allowed to settle just off the leaders down the backstretch, rallied four wide on the final turn and into the stretch, and closed strongly from the outside to draw clear. LOOKOUT DUBAI away well and raced one from the rail into the first turn while pressing the pace, vied for the lead from along the rail down the backside, held a narrow advantage into the stretch but was unable to hold off the late charge by MATCHABULL. GENTLE JOE broke sharply and was carried four wide into the first turn, chased three wide down the backstretch, attempted to rally along the inside entering the stretch but lacked the needed closing response. P S FORGET ME NOT squeezed at the start and was forced to steady slightly, trailed the field into the first turn racing three wide, posted a mild bid four wide on the final turn and into the lane, and was gaining in deep stretch. THE PHENOM away alertly and led racing three wide into the first turn, continued on down the backstretch while pressing the pace from just off the rail, but faded over the final furlong.
