LITTLE BROWN GUY raced mid pack one from the rail into the backstretch, commenced a three wide rally on the final turn and was up in the closing strides racing four wide under left handed urging. CAT'S AXE broke sharply and dueled for the early lead from along the rail,entered the backstretch with a clear lead, repelled a mid race challenge by SPY ZONE, but was unable to hold off LITTLE BROWN GUY in the closing strides. DOG ROCK hustled three wide into the first turn, drifted five wide around the turn, continued along on the outside down the backstretch, angled in to save ground on the final turn and was gaining from along the inside in deep stretch. NINE O'CLOCK GUN unhurried early while dropping back to trail, advanced along the inside down the backstretch, tipped three wide on the final turn, and closed four wide in the stretch. SPY ZONE away alertly to duel two wide for the early lead, re-engaged CAT'S AXE mid way down the backstretch,but hung in the final furlong. MADOC was jostled at the start and took an awkward step when in tight, raced one from the rail into the first turn, was three and four wide racing down the backstretch and was only able to offer a mild bid on the final turn. THE BARTON BOY away well and stalked the early pacesetters from along the rail, but faded over the final furlong. MY ANNIVERSARY raced three wide throughout and showed little.
