LONESOME KAT 3 wide on the first turn, steadily advanced, assumed command and prevailed driving. CHELAN in the middle of the pack, rallied, closed willingly and finished well. QUILLO never far back, rallied 3 wide and closed willingly. DEPUTY DOT COM away alertly, pressed the pace and tired, gave way. HOLD THE SWEETS away alertly, showed good early speed, set the pace and tired. GOOD TO THE CORE unhurried early, showed little and failed to menace. FAITHFUL GAL slow early, showed little. RARE INDIGO 3 wide on the first turn, drifted and was through early.
