Footnotes

CALM THE STORM away alertly, and tracked the pacesetter one from the rail entering the first turn, continued from a tracking position in the run down the backstretch, engaged the leader approaching the final turn, took command leaving the turn and quickly drew clear. BECKSTOFFER was bumped soon after the start, but recovered quickly and rushed up from along the rail to assume command entering the first turn, was collared by the winner entering the final turn, and while no match for that rival, proved clearly second best. GJOLA MISS away well, but dropped back off the top pair entering the first turn, and settled back entering the backstretch racing along the inside, rallied two wide entering the final turn, was unable to threaten the top pair, but was clearly best of the rest. WEE BLUE BAYOU broke sharply, and was allowed to settle off the early pace racing one from the rail entering the first turn, rallied two wide entering the final turn, but lacked the needed closing response to make her presence felt. STERLING AVENUE unhurried early, while dropping back to trail, and made no impact.
