LADY VITESSE broke sharply and was close up, chased the pace setter from off the rail, gained the lead on the backstretch, drew clear on the final turn and won driving. DANCER'S HALO never far back, stalked the pace from off the rail, made a middle move from three wide, finished well as second best. CAHILL CASEY trailed for the first half mile, gaining, three wide on the backstretch, rallied and weakened. MAMA KAY close up on the inside, chased the leaders, weakened after three quarters. HOW IZ IT SARAH broke sharply, assumed command from the inside, set the pace, gave way. STELLA STELLA unhurried early, gaining, three wide on the backstretch, was through after three quarters. PERFECT PEGGY hustled along, stalked the pace from off the rail, was through after three quarters. BIG DEAL LUCILLE off a step slow, unhurried early, dropped back to trail.
