Footnotes

TENZEL away alertly and dueled for the lead entering the first turn racing one from the rail, raced uncontested for the lead down the backside, turned back a challenge from MAZEL'S SECRET through the final turn, and drew clear through the stretch. MAZEL'S SECRET stalked the early pace into the first turn racing one from the rail, advanced three wide approaching the final turn to engage TENZEL entering the turn, but was unable to stay with that rival through the stretch and was all out to hold the place. FREETHEBLUES was off a step slow, raced three wide into the first turn and down the backside, rallied two from the rail entering the final turn and closed willingly four wide through the lane. PVT. SALLY WILSON away well and stalked the leaders from along the inside entering the first turn, was forced to steady sharply off heels mid way through the turn, tracked the leaders from along the rail into the final turn but hung in the stretch drive. GOLDEN EARS raced four wide into the first turn while devoid of early speed, continued from the outside down the backside and into the final turn and failed to menace. SEATTLE BRASH LISA broke sharply and vied for the lead from along the rail entering the first turn, began to drop back before entering the backstretch, steadily retreated and was eased through the stretch.
