### Footnotes

PAY ME NOTIS away alertly and raced to the lead entering the first turn while racing one from the rail, held command throughout, and drew off in deep stretch. HASTY REPLY broke sharply and chased the early leader from along the rail into the first turn, continued to chase through the final turn but was unable to keep up with the winner in the stretch drive but was clearly second best. PLANE JANE allowed to settle off the early leaders through the stretch the first time racing one from the rail, rallied three wide on the final turn and improved her position through the final furlong without ever seriously threatening. GRIEVANCE was off a step slow and dropped back to trail, rallied one from the rail on the final turn and improved her position through the lane. EXOTIC LIGHT away well and tracked the pace three wide into the first turn and down the backstretch, rallied three wide through the final turn but lacked the needed closing response. SECRET SATIN saved ground throughout while racing along the rail, but failed to menace. FLAMES ABLAZIN tracked the leaders four wide through the stretch the first time, angled in to save ground entering the backstretch, appeared to jump the tracks from the gate, and raced rank down the backstretch losing all chances. MAGIC THUNDER tracked the leaders one from the rail into the second turn, advanced three wide soon after entering the backside, but weakened over the final furlong.
