SECOND ECLIPSE unhurried early while dropping back to trail racing one from the rail into the backstretch, rallied along the inside on the final turn, tipped four wide entering the stretch, and drifted five wide under left handed urging and was up in the final strides. PUMPKIN MOONSHINE broke sharply, and vied for the lead from along the rail entering the first turn, battled through the final turn and into the stretch from the inside of FOURTEENFORTY, put that rival away in deep stretch, but was unable to hold off SECOND ECLIPSE in the final strides. BARKLEY BAY settled off the early pace racing three wide into the backstretch, rallied one from the rail entering the final turn, shifted out mid way through the turn and closed with a rush six wide in the lane to just miss. FOURTEENFORTY away alertly, and dueled for the lead from the outside of PUMPKIN MOONSHINE entering the first turn, battled with that rival through the final turn, and into the stretch, but was outfinished in the late going. GENERAL QUESTION tracked the dueling leaders into the backstretch racing one from the rail, rallied two wide entering the final turn, but needed more of a closing response in the stretch drive. STONERIDGE RAIDER stalked the leaders one from the rail entering the first turn, rallied two wide entering the final turn, but faded in the stretch drive. STEPMOTHER'S BOY stalked the pacesetters into the backstretch racing two from the rail, but lacked the needed closing response when called upon approaching the final turn. SLEWS LUCKY LEE lagged well back in the early going, while saving ground at the rail entering the first turn, but showed little.
