### Footnotes

KIRI'S GAL away alertly, and raced to the lead from along the rail entering the first turn, opened a clear advantage in the run down the backstretch, and was never seriously threatened. ALWAYSREDONSUNDAY broke sharply, and stalked the leader in the run to the first turn, brushed the rail approaching the turn for a few strides,rallied one from the rail entering the final turn, awaited room from behind rivals leaving the turn, and closed willingly three wide through the stretch to get up for the place in the last jump. UNIQUA tracked the leader two wide racing into the first turn, held a stalking position in the run to the final turn, rallied two wide on the turn and closed willingly, while getting nipped for the place in the closing strides. C. A. MISS was bumped soon after the start, settled off the early pace racing one from the rail entering the first turn, rallied three wide on the final turn, and closed four wide in the stretch drive. ROADESSA unhurried early, while dropping back to trail racing one from the rail, rallied two wide entering the final turn and closed with some late interest two wide in the drive. OFFICER'S CHARM away well, and tracked the leader into the first turn racing along the rail, held a tracking spot to the final turn before weakening.
