Footnotes

DRAFTING FOR SPEED broke sharply and chased the early pacesetter one from the rail entering the first turn, raced three wide down the backstretch while pressing OUR COCO BEANS, collared that rival on the final turn and inched clear in the stretch drive. OUR COCO BEANS away alertly and led into the first turn while racing along the inside, held a narrow advantage down the backstretch, dueled on the final turn with DRAFTING FOR SPEED but was unable to stay with that foe in the late stages. TICK ME OFF unhurried early and trailed the field throughout most of the journey, closed from along the inside on the final turn, and was gaining in the stretch racing one from the rail. UPPER CRUST stalked the early pace while racing just off the rail, posted a mild bid nearing the final turn but hung in the stretch drive. GOLDEN RATIO away well and chased the early pacesetter into the first turn racing three wide, tracked the leaders from the outside down the backstretch but had little to offer in the final furlong.
