JOINT CHOICE away alertly and raced to a clear early lead from along the rail, widened his advantage on the turn, and was being geared down late as much the best. HIT N MISS broke sharply and chased the pacesetter into the turn from one off the rail, was no match for the winner but proved clearly second best. OSCAR AWARD steadied in the run away from the gate when squeezed between rivals, rallied along the rail on the turn and closed one from the rail through the stretch. VIRTUAL TIME ducked in at the start to get away slowly, advanced from along the rail mid way through the turn and down the stretch. GRAFFITI GRACE chased three wide into the turn, and six wide in the stretch and was unable to threaten. KACHING CASH was slow into stride and never menaced. ENDLESS SONG away well and chased four wide into the turn, bore out entering the turn and was never a factor after that.
