CAGED MISTRESS broke sharply and stalked the early pace while racing one from the rail, rallied three wide through the final turn and was up in the closing strides for the victory. WANDO WOMAN unhurried early while dropping back to trail, raced just out from the rail down the backstretch, rallied one from the rail on the final turn, and closed strongly two wide through the stretch and just missed. OVERVALUED away alertly and raced to the lead one from the rail into the first turn, held a narrow advantage into the second turn from the outside of HEIDI MARIA, turned back a challenge from ORCHID'S SILVER through the final turn but was unable to hold off the deep closers late. ORCHID'S SILVER away well and tracked the early leader racing three wide through the second turn, rolled up to press OVERVALUED mid way down the backstretch while getting her nose in front approaching the final turn, battled through the final turn from the outside of that rival, checked briefly soon after entering the stretch when OVERVALUED shifted out slightly, and faded in deep stretch. TIERRA DEL FEUGO was off a step slow, raced three wide into the second turn, advanced three wide soon after entering the backstretch to gain a striking position, but weakened over the final furlong. HEIDI MARIA steadied when in tight quarters entering the first turn, tracked the leader from along the inside through the second turn, but faded in the late stages.
