SIR RONRICO ducked in soon after the start to get away slowly, advanced one from the rail approaching the final turn, tipped three wide entering the stretch and ran down NESKOWIN in the final strides. NESKOWIN away alertly and rushed to the lead from along the inside entering the first turn, increased his advantage entering the final turn, but was unable to hold off SIR RONRICO in the final strides. DICKSTEIN showed no early speed while lagging well back,raced three wide into the backstretch, rallied four wide on the final turn and closed willingly five wide through the stretch to get up for a share. NO MORE DRAMA chased the early pace racing five wide into the first turn, continued on from the extreme outside in the run to the final turn, rallied five wide through the turn, and hung slightly in the stretch drive. BRAVE STAR away well and chased the pace into the first turn racing one from the rail, tracked the pacesetter into the final turn but lacked the needed closing response. MUD SHADOW stalked the leader into the first turn racing along the rail, chased the leaders down the backside from along the inside but began to weaken approaching the final turn. OKANAGAN CHARLIE broke sharply and chased the pacesetter three wide into the first turn, continued to chase to the final turn before gradually fading. BERTORNEY chased four wide into the first turn, lost ground through the turn while dropping back to trail and was never a factor.
