MR. COLLABORATOR away alertly to assume command entering the first turn while racing just out from the rail, was collared by STOLENOTIS down the backstretch, dueled with that rival through the final turn and into the stretch but inched clear in the late stages. STOLENOTIS chased the early pacesetter into the first turn racing three wide, engaged MR. COLLABORATOR soon after entering the backstretch, dueled with that foe through the final turn and into the lane but was unable to match strides in the late going. WHISTLER GOLD broke sharply and chased the early pace into the first turn racing one from the rail,sat a tracking trip behind the dueling leaders down the backstretch, but was unable to make up ground when called upon in an even effort. HORNBLLOWER hopped slightly at the start, raced three wide throughout, advanced three wide mid way down the backstretch and around the final turn but was unable to threaten. ROMANCIN TRAVELLER away well to stalk the early leaders while racing one from the rail, remained in striking position into the final turn but lacked the needed closing response. FINAL FLAIR raced one from the rail through the early stages but never menaced. OUTFOTHECLOUDS trailed throughout and was never a factor.
