Footnotes

KWIK raced one from the rail in the early stages, began to advance three wide upon entering the backstretch for the second time, rallied three wide around the final turn and took command entering the stretch and drew clear. SUPER STEVE away alertly and raced to an early lead from along the rail, turned back challenges by both SAY FABULOUS and ORCHID'S SILVER, held the lead into the final turn and while unable to hold off KWIK in the final furlong, finished well to prove second best. RALLYING CRY stalked the early pace racing one from the rail, rallied three wide on the final turn and finished evenly. KALOOKAN BOSS saved ground through the early stages, dropped back to trail entering the backstretch the second time, tipped off the rail and mounted a four wide move down the backside and around the final turn and was closing late. SAY FABULOUS broke sharply and chased the early pace while one from the rail, pressed the pacesetter down the backstretch but weakened in the late stages. ROSES FOR BEN unhurried early, raced three wide throughout and never menaced. LONG GONE BALDRY away well and tracked the early leaders racing three wide, but steadily retreated. ORCHID'S SILVER stalked the early pace while racing three wide, loomed a danger as she engaged three wide upon entering the backstretch for the second time, but faded in the final furlong. KANONKULE raced one from the rail through the early going, advanced three wide approaching the final turn but hung in the late stages.
