MOSCATO broke sharply, gained command, set the pace, was headed on the final turn, cane again to retake the lead and won driving. NUMAANY broke sharply and was close up, chased the leaders from three wide, gained the lead on the final turn, gave way. CLASSIC IDEALS away alertly and well placed, tracked the leaders from the inside, rallied and was outrun in the stretch. SHENANDOAH RIVER broke sharply, pressed the pace from the outside, gave way after three quarters. HAPPY GO LUCKY unhurried early, stalked the pace from off the rail, four wide in the stretch, was outrun. HARLEM in the middle of the pack, stalked the pace from three wide, failed to menace. OLAXSA unhurried early, made a middle move from the inside, failed to menace. GREAT PRINCE slow early and three wide, showed little and was not a threat. DIAMONDS LIL DEVIL off slowly, trailed for most of the trip and showed little. CANDY KING unhurried early, made a middle move from three wide, dropped back.
