Footnotes

MEDANO BEACH broke sharply but had to steady early in the run away from the gate when put in tight at the rail, chased the early pacesetter one from the rail into the first turn and down the backstretch, engaged MASS FLORA for the lead mid way down the backside,took a short lead into the stretch and held the closers at bay. DE VILBISS stalked the early pacesetters while saving ground at the rail, was forced to steady entering the backstretch when running up on heels,tipped three wide entering the stretch and was gaining late. MASS FLORA away alertly and led the field into the first turn while racing along the rail,battled with MEDANO BEACH around the final turn and down the stretch, battled gamely through the stretch and steadied nearing the wire. ICECAP reared at the start to get away extremely poorly, saved ground throughout while racing along the rail, advanced along the inside entering the final turn and was closing fastest of all in the stretch one from the rail. EXCLUSIVE CASH bumped at the start, tracked the leaders into the first turn and down the backstretch while racing three wide, offered a mild bid approaching the final turn but lacked the needed closing response. WHAT ABOUT JOEY bumped at the start, saved ground throughout while racing along the rail but never menaced. Following the running of the race the stewards conducted two separate enquiry's. One into the start of the race involving ICECAP, and one involving MEDANO BEACH and MASS FLORA nearing the wire. After review the stewards deemed that all horses received a fair start, and in the incident nearing the wire, the stewards disqualified MEDANO BEACH from first and placed this horse third for drifting in and forcing the rider of MASS FLORA to steady.
