LIBERTY CAP away alertly, and tracked the pacesetter into the stretch the first time racing along the inside, continued from a tracking position to the final turn, set sail after the leader with a two wide rally entering the final turn, took command in mid stretch and inched clear. WILO KAT stalked the pace one from the rail through the stretch the first time, steadied off heel leaving the second turn when trapped behind rivals, rallied along the inside on the final turn, and closed gamely three wide in deep stretch while unable to overcome the early trouble. MYSTERIOUS SOUL was bumped at the start to get away a step slow, circled four wide entering the first turn, and assumed a tracking position three wide entering the stretch the first time, continued down the backstretch from a striking position, rallied three wide on the final turn, and closed willingly four wide in the lane in a solid effort. SIMILKAMEEN JOEY away well, and raced to the lead from just off the rail entering the first turn, controlled the pace through the final turn, was collared by the winner soon after entering the stretch, and gave way grudgingly. RUFFY JOE settled off the early pace racing along the inside entering the second turn, rallied three wide entering the final turn, and closed two from the rail in the drive, but needed more. CREW LEADER unhurried early while dropping back to trail, advanced five wide mid way down the backstretch to gain a striking position, but needed more of a closing response in the late stages. FRANSOR'S FINEST stalked the pacesetters three wide into the second turn, rallied four wide entering the final turn, but was outfinished in the stretch drive.
