MR. COOPER hesitated at the start and trailed the field from the onset, rallied one from the rail on the final turn, tipped five wide entering the stretch and closed with a rush to get up in the final strides. ARKHILL allowed to settle through the early going racing two from the rail into the first turn, rallied five wide through the final turn, took command soon after entering the stretch but was unable to hold off MR. COOPER in the closing strides. WHISTLER GOLD allowed to settle well off the dueling leaders entering the first turn racing one from the rail, rallied four wide through the final turn, took up slightly leaving the final turn when awaiting room, and closed well through the stretch. ICE RULES stalked the early leaders three wide into the first turn, loomed a danger four wide entering the final turn, but hung in the stretch drive. VERNON CAT away alertly and vied for the lead from along the rail into the first turn, battled through the final turn from along the inside, but faded in the stretch drive. EMANCIPATED broke sharply and dueled for the lead into the first turn and down the backside three wide from between rivals, dropped back slightly on the final turn, steadied leaving the turn, and weakened. PEACE BEAR away well and pressed the pace four wide into the first turn, continued to press the issue until taking a narrow advantage into the final turn, but faded in the stretch drive.
