Footnotes

DANNY'S CHANT broke sharply and dueled for the lead one from the rail through the first turn, took command soon after entering the backstretch, held the lead through the final turn and was never seriously threatened through the late stages. LOTS OF CASH away alertly and vied for the early lead from along the rail entering the first turn, took back off the leader entering the backstretch to assume a tracking position, chased two wide around the final turn and proved clearly second best while unable to seriously challenge the winner. TECOLOTE away well and stalked the dueling leaders through the first turn, tracked the leader three wide entering the backstretch, held a striking position into the final turn but lacked the needed closing response when called upon. NAUGHTY LIBRARIAN allowed to settle off the early pace racing one from the rail into the backstretch, rallied three wide through the final turn but needed more in the final furlong. ACCEPTABLE HENNA allowed to settle well off the early leaders into the backstretch racing one from the rail, rallied four wide into the final turn but failed to menace. CHANTOOZIE allowed to settle off the leaders while saving ground at the rail, but began to fade nearing the final turn. WHOSECASH unhurried early while dropping back to trail, and failed to make an impact.
