LADY'S JEWEL away alertly, gained command, led throughout on the two path, drew off driving through the last quarter. CATAHOULA ROSE away alertly and allowed to settle, rallied from three wide down the stretch, was up for the place. INISH GLORA away alertly, chased the leaders on a four wide trip, weakened in the stretch. WITHOUTAPPROVAL slow early, was advancing on a three wide trip, rallied four wide down the stretch and finished well. MAGIC DANCER unhurried early, showed little and failed to menace. QUEEN OF MY NIGHTS away alertly, pressed the pace from the outside, was through after three quarters and gave way. UP TO ME away alertly, dropped back, showed little and was not a factor. IVY LANE off slowly, hustled along to be four wide on the first turn, was hard used and through after that.
