ARKHILL away alertly and stalked the early leader racing three wide, rallied one from the rail entering the final turn, took command entering the stretch and drew clear under steady urging. LORNEFIVEHUNDRED chased three wide into the first turn to eventually take command, drew off to a clear lead down the stretch the first time, held a wide margin into the final turn but was unable to hold off ARKHILL as he began to weaken in the late stages, but held welol for the place. SWISS ARROGANT unhurried early while saving ground at the rail, rallied two wide on the final turn and closed ground through the stretch. VYING FOR GLORY broke sharply and took a brief lead into the first turn, took a stalking entering the stretch the first time, chased LORNEFIVEHUNDRED down the backstretch but faded slightly over the final furlong. HUFFMAN stalked four wide into the first turn, steadied entering the stretch the first time around when on heels, offered a mild bid entering the backstretch but never seriously menaced. TEXAS BUCCANEER unhurried early while dropping back to trail, and showed little. NUMAANY away well and stalked the early pace while racing along the rail, was forced to steady when in tight entering the stretch the first time, and was pulled up on the backstretch, and walked off.
