Footnotes

DASHING DAISY stalked the pacesetters racing three wide into the first turn, raced four wide down the backstretch while tracking the leaders, rallied three wide on the final turn and took command entering the stretch and was able to hold off DAYMAKER late. DAYMAKER raced three wide down the backstretch while allowed to settle, rallied four wide on the final turn and closed six wide in the stretch and was clearly second best. TERLANI away well and stalked the early pace while saving ground at the rail, advanced from between rivals mid way down the backstretch to take a narrow lead into the final turn but faded in the late stages. INDY BEAUTY broke sharply and dueled for the early lead while racing one from the rail, raced three wide down the backstretch, but weakened in the stretch drive. AUDZEEZEE unhurried early while dropping back to trail racing one from the rail, closed five wide through the stretch to improve her position without ever threatening. SWEET N SOUR away alertly and vied for the early lead from along the rail, but began to weaken approaching the final turn. MIZZ SHAKIN raced mid pack one from the rail through the early stages but lacked any kind of a response.
