MAUDEST DANCER stalked the early pace while racing three wide into the first turn, raced four wide down the backstretch while maintaining a striking position, rallied three wide on the final turn and closed five wide in the stretch, took command in deep stretch and drew clear. DECLAN DOWNS broke sharply and chased the early leader three wide into the first turn, continued on from the outside down the backstretch, rallied one from the rail entering the final turn, turned for home with a narrow lead but was unable to hold off MAUDEST DANCER in deep stretch but was easily second best. BOSCO'S QWIK chased the early pacesetter four wide into the first turn, pressed three wide down the backstretch, battled with DECLAN DOWNS into the lane but faded in the late stages. VICTORY CLAP unhurried early while racing one from the rail and was only able to offer a mild bid in the final furlong. ANOTHEROUNDBARKEEP raced mid pack while saving ground at the rail but was unable to improve his position in an even effort. FISH ON FRIDAY showed no speed early while trailing the field and was only able to pass tiring rivals in the stretch. A LASTING PEACE away alertly and led one from the rail into the first turn, but began to fade entering the final turn and had nothing left for the stretch drive. LATE NITE LARRY away well and stalked the early pace from along the rail, but steadily retreated mid way down the backstretch.
