Footnotes

ANNADU away well and tracked the early pacesetters while saving ground along the rail, maintained a tracking position through the final turn, took command from along the inside in deep stretch and inched clear. B. C. CAT vied for the early lead while racing one from the rail into the first turn, held a narrow advantage into the stretch but was unable to hold off ANNADU, while all out to hold the place. SARATOGA OUTLAW away alertly and dueled for the lead while racing three wide into the first turn, pressed the issue down the backside, chased B.C. CAT through the final turn and finished well in a solid effort. REMARKABLY FREE broke sharply, but was allowed to settle off the dueling leaders three wide into the first turn, rallied two wide through the final turn and was gaining ground through the stretch drive. GOLDEN RATIO unhurried early while dropping back to trail, rallied four wide through the final turn, and closed willingly six wide through the stretch. DINA LIGHT bumped at the start, stalked the pacesetters into the backstretch while racing one from the rail, but lacked the needed closing response when called upon. TAMARINDA stalked the pace three wide into the backstretch, advanced four wide mid way down the backside, but weakened over the final furlong.
