J J'S WANDER angled in to save ground entering the first turn, raced along the rail down the backstretch,rallied along the rail on the final turn, and closed from between rivals in the stretch to get up in time. SONGSROYALDIAMOND raced three wide into the first turn while tracking the leaders, raced four wide down the backside, rallied three wide on the final turn and closed well in the stretch from the outside to just miss. R DUBAI GIRL was bumped approaching the first turn and forced to steady slightly, raced mid pack down the backstretch one from the rail, swung six wide into the stretch and was gaining late. SNOWBIRD PASS was in tight approaching the first turn and bumped a rival to her outside, tracked the pacesetters into the backstretch, slipped through along the inside to vie for the lead mid way down the backside, held a narrow advantage into the final turn but weakened slightly in the late stages. MAIDA VALE away well and tracked the pacesetters from along the rail, saved ground throughout but lacked the needed closing response. FISHERS CATCH raced three wide into the first turn and down the backstretch, angled in entering the stretch and advanced from just off the rail in the lane but had to check when in tight nearing the finish. BALEA away alertly and vied for the early lead from along the rail, dueled two wide down the backstretch but weakened in the stretch drive. TAMAHl raced wide throughout and was never a factor. POSTESS broke sharply and dueled for the early lead racing one from the rail but faded over the final furlong. MAGIC THUNDER raced one from the rail and never menaced.
