MEAUX POWER away well and tracked the dueling leaders into the backstretch while racing two from the rail, advanced four wide approaching the final turn and quickly took command and opened a clear lead entering the turn and was able to hold DE CAR GUY safely at bay through the stretch. DE CAR GUY broke sharply and tracked the dueling leaders into the backstretch while racing one from the rail, rallied two wide through the final turn, was unable to seriously threaten the winner but proved clearly second best. OLAXSA allowed to settle off the early pace racing one from the rail into the second turn, rallied three wide through the final turn and finished evenly in a solid effort. TOO MUCH DIRT unhurried early while dropping back to trail, rallied along the inside through the final turn and improved his position while unable to threaten. GUNS N GOLD allowed to settle off the early pace racing three wide, but failed to menace. HONEY'S MONARCH vied for the lead from along the inside entering the first turn, battled down the backstretch from the inside of MUCHO VERDE, but weakened over the final furlong. MUCHO VERDE away alertly and dueled for the early lead one from the rail into the first turn, battled with HONEY'S MONARCH down the backside, was collared by MEAUX POWER approaching the final turn, and weakened soon thereafter.
