Footnotes

VYING FOR VICTORY raced four wide into the first turn carrying a rival out with him, advanced two from the rail down the backside to gain a striking position entering the final turn, rallied one from the rail through the turn and closed willingly three wide through the stretch to get up in time. JOSHUA JET FUEL broke sharply and tracked the early leader one from the rail through the first turn, rallied one from the rail entering the final turn, took a narrow advantage soon after entering the stretch but was unable to hold off VYING FOR VICTORY in deep stretch. DREXEL was carried five wide entering the first turn, dropped back entering the backstretch to lag well off the pace, rallied three wide through the final turn, tipped seven wide into the lane and closed with interest. FRESH MANGOLD stalked the early pace racing three wide down the backside, advanced three wide approaching the final turn to loom a danger but needed more of a closing response through the final furlong. HUFFMAN away alertly and raced to the lead from along the rail entering the first turn, held a narrow advantage through the final turn, but faded in the stretch drive. W W WANDERER away well and advanced along the rail entering the first turn to assume a stalking position entering the backstretch, but began to weaken approaching the final turn. SUE'S BOY SUE unhurried early, and trailed throughout.
