### Footnotes

MY BAILOUT broke sharply and vied for the lead from along the rail entering the first turn, chased LASTING SPICE into the final turn from along the inside, battled back from along the rail entering the stretch to regain command and inched clear through the lane. LASTING SPICE away well and dueled for the lead one from the rail into the first turn, held a narrow advantage into the final turn, but was unable to put away a determined MY BAILOUT when she battled back along the inside entering the stretch. NOTIS HER away alertly and tracked the leaders into the first turn racing four wide, assumed a stalking position behind the dueling leaders down the backside, rallied two wide through the final turn, and finished evenly. DELTA BOUQUET unhurried early while dropping back to trail, rallied along the inside on the final turn and gained ground through the stretch from along the rail. HOLY KUGA stumbled at the break, rushed up to track the leaders one from the rail into the first turn, held a striking position to the final turn before fading in the late going. DIANA'S LEGACY allowed to settle off the early leaders racing one from the rail into the backside, rallied four wide entering the final turn, but weakened in the stretch drive. CAMINO tracked the leaders three wide through the first turn, began to drop back soon after entering the backstretch and was through early.
