Footnotes

DILWYN away well and stalked the dueling leaders down the backside while saving ground at the rail, continued to track the pacesetters through the final turn while awaiting room, split rivals soon after entering the stretch and emerged with the lead in mid stretch and was all out to hold off a closing QUATRILL'S RAIDER in the closing strides. QUATRILL'S RAIDER stalked the dueling leaders into the backside while racing two from the rail, rallied three wide through the final turn and closed willingly six wide through the stretch to just miss. PROFIT'S STAR away alertly and tracked the battling leaders into the backstretch racing one from the rail, engaged the leaders four wide entering the final turn, and battled gamely through the stretch in a solid effort. PUNA POINT showed no early speed while lagging well back, rallied three wide into the final turn, tipped seven wide entering the stretch and closed willingly. LITTLE BROWN GUY allowed to settle off the early leaders racing one from the rail, rallied three wide through the final turn and closed willingly two from the rail through the stretch. SILVER RULER raced wide throughout, rallied four wide on the final turn and closed eight wide through the stretch. VYING FOR GLORY broke sharply and dueled for the lead one from the rail into the first turn, continued to battle down the backside from the outside of BLOOD AND

DIAMOND, held a narrow advantage into the stretch but faded in the late going. BLOOD AND DIAMOND vied from along the rail for the lead entering the first turn, battled from the inside of VYING FOR GLORY through the final turn before fading in the stretch drive. CHAPEL BOY unhurried early while dropping back to trail, and failed to menace. PRINCIPE'S HERBIE was squeezed soon after the start to get away slowly, advanced from along the inside through the first turn and into the backside, but weakened over the final furlong.
