### Footnotes

MY DUBAI away well, and tracked the early pacesetter one from the rail entering the first turn, collared the leader entering the final turn, took command leaving the turn and inched clear through the stretch. PAYTON'S BEST broke sharply, and raced to a narrow advantage from along the inside entering the first turn, was collared by the winner entering the final turn, and while no match for that rival, battled gamely through the lane to hold the place. WHO'S DADDY IS DAT away alertly, and stalked the leaders one from the rail entering the first turn, held a striking position to the final turn, rallied two wide entering the turn, and closed willingly three wide through the stretch to just miss the place. AFLEET CHANCE unhurried early, while dropping back to trail, raced two from the rail in the run down the backstretch, rallied three wide into the final turn, and closed with late interest four wide in the drive. LEGAL BANDIT stalked the leaders from along the rail entering the first turn, continued from a stalking position into the backstretch, but lacked the needed closing response when called upon approaching the final turn, and faded.
