Footnotes

ROCKY'S QUEST away alertly and vied for the early lead from along the rail, was collared and briefly overtaken on the final turn but re-rallied entering the stretch and took command and held on for the victory. QUEEN'S VICAR away well and dueled for the early lead while racing one from the rail, pressed three wide down the backstretch, briefly took the lead mid way through the final turn, but was outfinished while proving second best. WAILIN' JACK broke sharply and stalked the early leaders while saving ground at the rail, commenced a two wide rally entering the final turn but was unable to make up ground through the stretch. FOREVERINTIME raced one from the rail while settling off the pacesetters, but was unable to threaten. BLAME THE BUBBLY unhurried early while racing one from the rail, but was never a factor. OUR WOODY lacked early speed while saving ground throughout, and was never a factor. MADOC chased three wide through the early stages but began to weaken over the final furlong.
