COLONEL COURTNEY away alertly and chased the early pacesetter into the first turn while saving ground at the rail,stalked the pace down the backstretch, rallied three wide into the stretch and drew clear in the lane. NOW ACT broke sharply and raced to an early lead entering the first turn racing one from the rail, held the lead into the final turn but was collared by COLONEL COURTNEY leaving the turn and could not match strides with that foe in the stretch but was clearly second best. COUNTRY KID away well and chased the pacesetter into the first turn racing three wide, was unable to threaten the top pair in the final furlong in an even effort. EL CUGAT raced three wide into the first turn, advanced four wide mid way down the backstretch to reach contention but hung in the final furlong. DUBA saved ground throughout while racing along the rail but failed to threaten.
