Footnotes

RED MOLLY rushed up to take command entering the first turn while one from the rail, turned back challenges from both ALITAX and ANDTHATSTHETRUTH mid way down the backstretch, opened a clear lead approaching the final turn and held the closers at bay through the stretch. ASH FORK away alertly and stalked the early pace from along the rail, saved ground throughout and was gaining in deep stretch. GOLDEN RATIO raced mid pack down the backstretch while four wide, rallied five wide around the final turn and drifted out wider through the stretch and failed to hold on for the place. ANDTHATSTHETRUTH away well and chased the early pace while racing three wide, posted a mild bid mid way down the backstretch, and finished evenly. WESTERN DELTA saved ground through the early stages while racing at the rail, rallied along the inside on the final turn and was gaining in deep stretch from between rivals. ALITAX broke sharply and chased the early pacesetter while racing just out from the rail, pressed RED MOLLY mid way down the backside, but was unable to match strides with that rival and faded over the final furlong. SALES GAL raced one from the rail and never menaced. RECALLED unhurried early while dropping back to trail, and was never a factor. TRIBAL SECRET angled in to save ground entering the first turn, but was never a serious threat.
