Footnotes

SASSY'S TREASURE broke sharply, pressed the early pace from the inside, gained the lead from two wide on the backstretch, drew clear in the stretch and won driving. THESEFOOLISHTHINGS four wide on the first turn to be close, chased the leaders, three wide on the backstretch, finished well as second best. AGAMEONE unhurried early, gaining on the inside, off the rail, rallied from three wide and finished well. RECALLED trailed for the first three quarters, put in a mild rally from three wide and finished well. LA BIKINA broke sharply and was close up, chased the leaders from off the rail, weakened in the stretch. MAGIC THUNDER broke sharply, allowed to settle, tracked the leaders from off the rail, was through after three quarters. WRATH OF THE FLAME three wide on the first turn, gained command, set the pace gave way.
