DASHING DAISY away well and stalked the early pacesetters while racing just out from the rail, awaited room on the final turn,rallied three wide into the stretch and drew clear while racing wide in the lane. WANDO WOMAN hesitated and missed the break to get away slowly, trailed the field into the backstretch while racing three wide, began to advance upon entering the backside, rallied four wide on the final turn, and closed from the far outside in the stretch. DEAREST PRINCESS broke sharply and chased the pace one from the rail in the early stages, pressed P.S. TOUCH DOWN for the lead down the backstretch, her rider lost her whip nearing the final turn, held the narrowest of leads leaving the final turn but faded slightly in the stretch drive. P. S. TOUCH DOWN away alertly and raced to an early lead just out from the rail, was pressed down the backstretch and weakened in deep stretch. RAINBOWSINTHEWOOD raced one from the rail while saving ground but never menaced. FINALITY PHILLY pressed the pace into the second turn while racing three wide, but weakened over the final furlong.
