Footnotes

LA BELLE ROSE stalked the early leaders racing three wide, engaged the pacesetters from the outside mid way down the backstretch, took command approaching the final turn and held the closers at bay through the stretch drive. CAMINO away well and saved ground while stalking the leaders from along the rail, rallied three wide into the stretch and was gaining late. VICTORY WITH CLASS stalked the early pacesetters while racing one from the rail, loomed a danger entering the final turn as she engaged from just off the rail but hung in the stretch drive. TECOLOTE unhurried early while racing three wide, advanced from the back of the field upon entering the backstretch while racing four wide, and closed six wide through the lane. AQUATIC away alertly and chased the early pace from just off the rail, vied for the lead from along the rail down the backstretch but faded over the final furlong. PRINCESSSES RULE showed no speed while trailing early and racing just out from the rail, offered a mild bid down the backstretch, but was never a serious factor. PIGTAILS raced mid pack through the early running one from the rail, but began to weaken on the run down the backside. LA BRONCA raced just out from the rail in the early going, posted a mild bid four wide down the backstretch and into the final turn to enter contention but faded in the late going. LUISINA broke sharply and led from along the rail into the second turn but was through mid way down the backstretch.
