SILKY SECRET away alertly, assumed command, set the pace and tired. MAKOPUNA slow early, had a mild bid inside and was outrun. DEPUTY DOT COM hustled along 3 wide, pressed the pace and tired. KATHY LOU away alertly, allowed to settle, saved ground and had no rally. GERI'S IMAGE slow early, showed little. NANCY O away alertly, dropped back and showed little. DANCERS BLOSSOM 3 wide on the first turn, was through early, dropped back. TOUCHED BY N ANGEL broke in air, appeared sore and pulled up. Following the race there was a stewards enquiry into the start. It was decided that all horses received a fair start. No change was made.
