NOT A LADY away alertly and well placed, chased the leaders, rallied from three wide, was up in the final strides driving. SAHARA'S ANGEL broke sharply, assumed command and drew clear, set the pace from off the rail, bumped with LA BIKINA on the second turn, just failed to last. NITE TIME NEWS never far back, gaining, rallied from three wide and finished well. LA BIKINA broke sharply and was well placed, chased the leaders from the inside, bumped with SAHARA'S ANGEL on the second turn, weakened. PIMENT ROUGE trailed for the first half mile, put in a mild rally from four wide and finished well. MAUI GOLD never far back, in tight early, saved ground, failed to menace. SUNDAY MISS hustled along, chased the leaders from three wide, was through after a half. Following the race there was a riders claim of foul. The rider of LA BIKINA claimed foul against the rider of SAHARA'S ANGEL for interference on the second turn. After review the claim was disallowed.
