LEO'S IN THE HOUSE away alertly, and raced to a narrow advantage from along the inside entering the first turn, controlled the pace in the run to the final turn, and drew clear in the stretch drive. STEVESTON LAD settled off the early pace racing one from the rail into the first turn, advanced from along the inside in the run to the final turn, briefly awaited room from along the inside approaching the final turn, tipped three wide entering the turn to commence his rally, and closed smartly three wide in deep stretch to get up for the place. WHAT GOES AROUND tracked the leader three wide entering the first turn, continued to tracked the pacesetter to the final turn, rallied two wide on the final turn, and just failed to hold the place while closing one from the rail. CAPTAIN SALT settled off the early pace racing five wide entering the first turn, continued to race wide down the backstretch, and rallied five wide into the final turn, and closed willingly four from the rail in the drive. SHOTGUN RALPH stalked the pace racing four wide into the first turn, rallied three wide entering the final turn, and closed four wide in the lane. TWOPENNY away well, and tracked the leader one from the rail into the first turn, held a striking position through the final turn, but faded in the stretch drive. CROSBY'S GOLD dropped back soon after the start after breaking sharply, trailed the field into the backstretch and showed little.
