**Footnotes**

MAZEL PRINT broke sharply, and raced to the lead one from the rail entering the first turn, dictated the pace throughout, and was able to hold off I'M FAMOUS in deep stretch, while drifting out slightly. I'M FAMOUS away alertly, and tracked the pacesetter from along the rail into the stretch the first time, continued to track the leader to the final turn, rallied three wide on the turn, and closed willingly four wide in the drive. GOLDEN FLASH away well, and was allowed to settle off the early pace while saving ground at the rail, rallied two wide entering the final turn, and improved his position in the stretch drive while closing one from the rail. CHAPEL BOY was off a step slow, advanced from along the rail entering the first turn to gain a stalking position, was forced to steady off heels leaving the first turn, continued down the backside from a stalking position at the rail, rallied along the inside on the final turn, had plenty of room along the inside entering the stretch. but flattened out in the late going. COUNTRY CASH unhurried early, while dropping back to trail, raced three wide into the second turn, and carried on four wide down the backstretch, rallied four wide on the final turn, and improved his position late, while unable to make a serious impact. HENRY WEST settled off the early pace while racing one from the rail through the second turn, rallied three wide into the final turn, but failed to menace. CROSSRAIL COURT stalked the leader three wide into the second turn, raced four wide in the run down the backstretch, and loomed a danger approaching the final turn, but faded over the final furlong.
