STORMIN FOR BECKA stalked the pacesetters racing three wide into the backstretch, rallied two from the rail entering the final turn, assumed command entering the stretch and quickly drew clear. GAMBINO broke sharply and pressed the leaders one from the rail into the first turn, tracked the pacesetter down the backside, rallied two wide through the final turn, was no match for the winner in the stretch but proved clearly second best. NORTH PACIFIC showed no early speed while lagging well back, raced three wide down the backside, rallied two from the rail entering the final turn, was carried six wide mid way through the turn while avoiding a fallen rider, and closed six wide through the stretch. LUCKYNUMBERFIVE away alertly and vied for the lead from along the inside entering the first turn, took a narrow advantage into the backstretch, battled through the final turn from along the inside of GAMBINO, but faded in the stretch drive. POLEBOUND allowed to settle off the early leaders racing one from the rail into the first turn, posted a mild bid entering the final turn, but lacked the needed closing response in the lane. LUDWIG allowed to settle through the early stages racing one from the rail, began to advanced two from the rail mid way down the backside, rallied two wide entering the final turn but was forced to steady sharply mid way through the turn while trying to avoid a fallen rider, and wasn't persevered with in the stretch. TEMPERED STEEL tracked the early leaders one from the rail into the first turn, checked off heels leaving the turn, and continued to track the pacesetters down the backside, angled in to commence her rally along the inside on the final turn, clipped heels mid way through the turn and unseated her rider. Following the running of this race, the stewards conducted an inquiry into the incident at the eighth pole. After review the stewards made no change to the original order of finish.
