**Footnotes**

BRASS AND GOLD away well, and stalked the leaders while saving ground at the rail through the second turn, rallied two wide entering the final turn, took command in mid stretch and drew clear. THE GOV away alertly, and pressed the pace one from the rail through the second turn, took a narrow lead into the final turn, was tackled by BRASS AND GOLD soon after entering the stretch, and while no match for that rival, proved clearly second best. WILO KAT stalked the pacesetters while racing one from the rail through the second turn, rallied two wide entering the final turn, and closed four wide through the lane. EL CAPONE was off a step slow, and settled off the early pace while saving ground at the rail through the second turn, rallied three wide entering the second turn, and improved his position without ever seriously threatening. SHINTOISM was forced to steady approaching the first turn, when in tight quarters, and dropped well back to lag near the back of the field, rallied four wide on the final turn, and improved his position over the final furlong. RUFFY JOE settled off the early leaders while racing one from the rail through the second turn, rallied two wide entering the final turn, but needed more while finishing one from the rail in the stretch drive. STORMY CANUCK tracked the leaders through the second turn while racing two from the rail, engaged the leader three wide entering the final turn, and pressed THE GOV through the turn, before weakening. SIMILKAMEEN JOEY broke sharply, and raced to a narrow advantage entering the first turn from along the rail, battled with THE GOV to the final turn, before fading. TRICK OF THE NORTH unhurried early, and trailed throughout.
